- At-A-Glance Bi-weekly Lesson Summary

- "Morning Messages" will be posted each school day with songs, poetry and a Scriptural devotional!
- Short instructional teacher-created videos for all new material!
- Daily Emphasis on core subjects of phonics/spelling, reading, math and musical grammar!
- Fun, hands-on projects in history and science every two weeks!
- Weekly small-group (Miss Nave & 5 students) Zoom Meetings (password-protected) for those interested.
- Whole Class Zoom Meeting on Fridays for Show & Tell and Weekly Review
- Coordinated Day Trips
- Creative Peer Connections including "Pen Pals" utilizing USPS.
- Teacher Availability Monday-Friday from 9-1.
- Face-to-Face Fridays (20 minute appointments with the teacher)
- Every Monday: Patriotic Pumas with Mrs. See
