- Mystery Box with everything your student needs to complete student activities for two weeks at a time.
- Google Classroom login for central hub where students access teacher-created videos, lessons, assignments, and assessments!
- “Morning Greetings” will be posted each school day with a teacher greeting, announcement, and Scriptural devotions to start their day off right!
- Daily Instructional Zoom Meetings for new material which will be recorded too!
- Subjects Emphasized: Math, Reading, Grammar & Composition, History, Science, Spelling and Bible!
- Small-group (Mrs. R & 6 students) Zoom Meetings (password-protected) 2-3/week
- Whole Class Zoom Meeting on Fridays for SHARE and Weekly Review
- Coordinated Day Trips
- Creative Peer Connections including “Pen Pals” utilizing USPS.
- Teacher Availability Monday-Friday from 9-1.
- Face-to-Face Fridays (20-30 minute appointments with the teacher)
- Every Monday: Patriotic Pumas with Mrs. See
