## Ongoing Fundraising Programs

### Scrip

Scrip is a funny word for paper or plastic card certificates from a wide variety of merchants. We purchase Scrip at a discount of 2% to 15% from the Great Lakes Scrip Center in Michigan. Then we sell the Scrip cards at face value. It costs you nothing extra. If you want \$25 of Starbucks, you get a card worth \$25. In the State of California, the Scrip does not expire! Attached is the “big Scrip list,” but we also have generous local merchants such as Whole Foods, Pacific Market, and Fircrest, that participate with PHCS. We keep Scrip for popular merchants (such as Safeway and Starbucks) on hand for purchase anytime at the school office and on Fridays at the pick-up area. You may also participate in our monthly, custom order. Scrip cards make great Christmas gifts and stocking stuffers! Do you know any small businesses that might consider ordering Scrip for their employee or customer gifts?

### eScrip

For more details visit [www.escrip.com](http://www.escrip.com). Register any or all of your existing grocery cards (Safeway, Olivers), debit cards, credit cards, and specific merchant cards with eScrip (must be done every year). To register, go to [www.escrip.com](http://www.escrip.com), choose “Sign Up” and then follow the steps. Our Pleasant Hill Christian School **Group ID# is 137596706**. PHCS will receive 1%-5% of your purchase when you use your club cards at checkout. There is no cost to you!

Safeway Club Card: Call 1-877-SAFEWAY (723-3929) to register for a club card or find out your existing number. Then register your Safeway club number at [escrip.com](http://escrip.com).

Oliver’s Market: Pick up a card at Oliver’s Market – our Group ID # is 137596706.

### Food Maxx/Lucky S.H.A.R.E.S Program

Supporting Humanities, Arts, Recreation, Education and Sports in our community. No sign-up or registration is require. Just pick up a card from the school office or Scrip Coordinator (Marjorie Broudy or Jennifer Kearney). Show your card before paying for your groceries, and PHCS will receive the benefits of a quarterly check for 3% of the qualified purchases. It’s that easy!

### Office Depot

Whenever you shop at Office Depot, give them the name of our school and our code number (70015156). They will give PHCS 5% of your purchase. Write this code number down in your wallet so you’ll have it ready. If you forget, they do have a binder at Office Depot that lists all the school numbers.

### Target Community Giving

There are two ways to glean \$ from Target for PHCS – a registered Target Visa credit card OR a registered Target debit card. Use either of these to pay for your store and online purchases at Target, and Target will give 1% to PHCS. It adds up – PHCS just received a check for \$365!

**Target Visa Credit Card:** Register your Target Visa credit card or apply for a card at a Target Store Customer Service Counter or online at [www.target.com](http://www.target.com). Use our **School ID # 21019**. When online, click on “Learn more” (at the bottom of the webpage below the REDcard section), click the tab on the left that says “Rewards and Benefits,” scroll down and select “Learn more about Take Charge of Education” and then “Find a School.” Fill in the requested information.

**Target Debit Card:** You may set up a Target debit card by visiting any Target Customer Service Counter. Bring a check from your checking account. Register this card at [www.target.com](http://www.target.com) or by calling 1-888-729-7331 or 1-800-729-7331.

## **Raley's Quality of Life Card**

Pick up a Quality of Life Card from Marjorie Broudy or the school office. Visit [www.raleys.com](http://www.raleys.com) online to complete your registration in 3 easy steps by clicking on "Neighborhood" and then "Quality of Life." Complete the Scrip beneficiary designation. You may then present your card at Raley's, BelAir and NobHill stores and PHCS will receive a portion of the proceeds.
