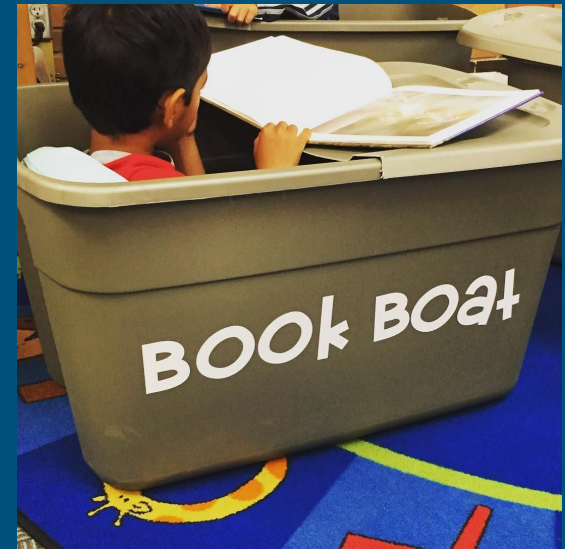

School Day Starts

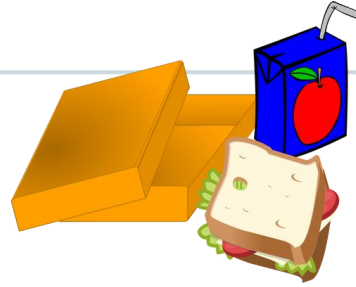
1. Entrance: Temperature Check in Car at Drop-Off
2. Touchless Hand Sanitizer Station
3. Backpacks Drop Off in Classroom
4. Students Play in Designated Zone Until Bell Rings
5. Outdoor Handwashing Stations & Line Up
6. Face coverings required to go inside





Bathrooms

Students get Personal Bathroom Pass Lanyard
Return for Handwashing in Classrooms
Disinfecting mid-day of toilets, sinks, and high-touch areas
by Staff



Snacks/Lunch

Cohorts wash hands before exiting classrooms
Cohorts are excused to outside recreational zones
Students go to Personal Outdoor Chair for Eating
Chairs are spaced for face to face groupings by Supervisors
Students eat, talk and clean up.
Snacks/Lunch boxes are dropped off in their Cohort Line

Dismissal

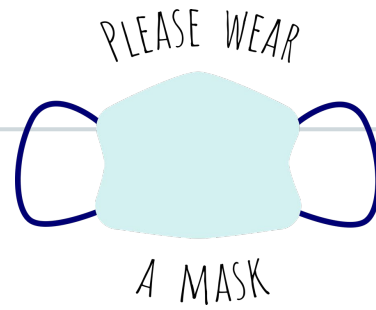
Cohorts will wait in their Classrooms

Pickup #1: TK-2nd Grades 3:00-3:15

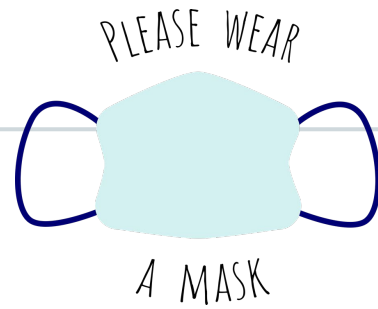
Pickup #2: 3-6th Grades at 3:15-3:30



Teacher & Staff Face Coverings

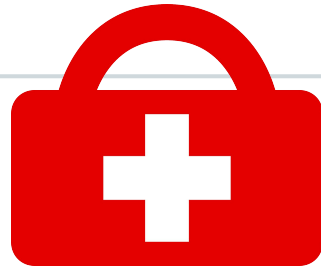
All Teachers & Staff are required to wear cloth face coverings OR clear face shields that wrap around face.

Any adults who enter the schoolhouse **MUST** Wear a cloth face covering. —



TK-6th Grade Face Coverings

Face coverings required indoors for all students and staff.
Outdoors face coverings are not required unless singing.
Students put masks on prior to entering building.



Student Health Screenings

Do not send your child to school if they are ill or running any type of fever over 99.8! Keep them home until there is no fever for 48 hours.

We will do visual checks and call parents if a student appears unwell. —

Temperatures will be taken each morning.





Teacher Health Screenings

Each morning, teachers and staff will have their temperatures taken and will be sent home immediately if they have any temperature over 99.8. Substitute teachers will also be screened before serving at the school. —



Healthy Hygiene Practices



- Thorough Handwashing before and after eating and after bathrooming will be mandatory.
- Coughs and sneezes will be directed into elbows. Handwashing afterwards will be required.
- Washable face masks should be washed daily at home.
- Disposable face masks are available at the front desk whenever needed.
- Students will be encouraged to not touch their faces throughout the day.
- Tissues will be available in multiple locations.



Cleaning & Disinfecting

- Daily Cleaning of High Traffic Areas
- Daily Wiping Down Student Personal Areas
- Daily Cleaning Bathrooms
- Daily Disinfecting Schoolhouse & Outdoor Play Areas
- Daily Disinfecting Personal Outdoor Chairs



Triggers to start PHCS At Home

If a student, staff member or family member of a student or staff member tests positive for Covid-19, **that cohort** will have to transition to our Distance Learning model called PHCS At Home. Each family is asked to sign a “hold-harmless” statement.

Each family needs to monitor their exposure in efforts to protect our PHCS school community.
