A significant part of Ms. Porter’s on campus class time starts each day as she creatively prepares students for the day with warm welcomes (songs, poetry, and stories) and community development time so students feel ready and eager to learn.”
- Literature-centric lessons (Audio/Video files read by Ms. Porter) like: Madeline, Ping, Mike Mulligan & His Steam Shovel, The Rag Coat, Papa Piccolo and more each week!
- Family Activities (games and activities that go along with story of the week)!
- Weekly Academic Highlights: Colors, Numbers, Letters, Sounds, Number Sense!
